android:layout_alignBaseline vs android:layout_alignBottom

Android Snippets - Align Baseline explained

When aligning TextViews in a Layout you may find android:layout_alignBaseline a useful formatting tool.

'Baseline' is a typograpical term and refers to the *line upon which most letters 'sit' and below which descenders 'extend'*.

Consider the example where we have two TextViews to present, the first of which has had android:padding="10dp" applied. If we were to try and use android:layout_alignBottom we would find the TextViews appear uneven due to the applied padding.

However, if we use android:layout_alignBaseline instead, the two TextViews appears beautifully aligned - nice!
